





# Strategic Review of the Integrated Programme of Work 2014-17

- Established UN rules and procedures for evaluations;
- ➤ Based on the ECE Biennial Evaluation Workplan 2016-2017;
- ➤ Evaluation will be carried out by an external consultant for the UNECE Programme Management Unit (PMU);
- ➤ Review the relevance of the UNECE/FAO Integrated Programme of Work in Forestry to member States;
- ➤ Report expected by Q3 2015.









## Strategic Review of the Integrated Programme of Work 2014-17 (cont.)

- Identifies challenges in the forest sector in the region;
- ➤ The outcome of the strategic review process will be essential for determination of priorities for the work beyond 2017;
- > To be presented to seventy fourth session of COFFI.
