High-level statement on the post-2015 development agenda and expected sustainable development goals

- "ECE is ideally placed to continue to make a strong contribution to sustainable development by", among others, "strengthening the sustainable management of ecosystems and natural resources".
- In cooperation with FAO, ECE contributes to the sustainable management of forests in the region and fosters the contribution of forests to a green economy".









Geneva UN Charter on Sustainable Housing

- Endorsed by Commission as non-legally binding instrument -> Habitat III
- Sustainability of the construction sector (minimizing environmental impact; reduction of carbon footprint throughout lifecycle of buildings)
- Wood/timber not explicitly mentioned, but: green homes/ green building
