ENTRY INTO FORCE OF THE AMENDMENTS TO ANNEXES 1, 2 AND 6

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, and referring to depositary notification C.N.328.1985.TREATIES-4 of 3 February 1986 transmitting the text in English, French and Russian of the amendments proposed to annexes 1, 2 and 6 of the Convention, communicates the following:

None of the Contracting Parties to the above-mentioned Convention having expressed an objection by 1 May 1986, the amendments in question, in accordance with the decision of the Administrative Committee, taken at its eighth session held in Geneva from 9 to 11 October 1985, will enter into force on 1 August 1986.
