GEORGIA: NOTIFICATION OF OBJECTION PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 60 (1)<sup>1</sup>

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary and with reference to depositary notification C.N.198.2009.TREATIES-2 of 8 April 2009, transmitting the texts of a proposal of amendment to Annex 6, Explanatory Note 0.8.3 of the above Convention, communicates the following:

On 30 September 2009, the Government of Georgia notified the Secretary-General of the following objection regarding the said amendment:

“Pursuant to the procedure set forth in paras 1 and 2 of the Article 60 of the Convention, the Government of Georgia would like to express its objection with regard to the decision of the Administrative Committee for the 1975 TIR Convention of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE), regarding the proposal to amend Annex 6, Explanatory Note 0.8.3, adopted at its forty-seventh session, held in Geneva on 5 February 2009.”
