GENEVA, 21 OCTOBER 1982

REPUBLIC OF MOLDOVA: ACCESSION

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,
communicates the following:

The above action was effected on 3 December 2008.

The Convention will enter into force for the Republic of Moldova on 3 March 2009 in
accordance with its article 17 (2) which reads as follows:

"After five States have deposited their instruments of ratification, acceptance, approval or
accession, this Convention shall enter into force for further Contracting Parties three months after the
date of the deposit of their instruments of ratification, acceptance, approval or accession."
