ACCEPTANCE OF THE AMENDMENTS PROPOSED BY HUNGARY
TO ANNEX I OF THE AGREEMENT¹

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary and with reference to depositary notification C.N.650.2006.TREATIES-2 of 9 August 2006 concerning the amendments proposed by the Government of Hungary to Annex I of the above Agreement, communicates the following:

Within the period of six months following the date of the above depositary notification, none of the Contracting Parties to the Agreement expressed an objection. Therefore, in accordance with paragraph 4 of article 11, the proposed amendments are deemed to be accepted.

Pursuant to the provisions of paragraph 5 of article 11, the amendments to the Agreement will enter into force for all Contracting Parties three months after the date of this notification, i.e., on 12 May 2007.
