**INFORMATION PAPER: COMMENTS ON ST/SG/AC.10/C.3/2001/43**

**Chapter 4.1 – Use of Packagings**  
**Proposal to amend Special Packing Provision PP1**

**Transmitted by the European Council of the Paint, Printing Ink and Artists Colours Industry**  
**(CEPE)**

**Background**

1. Since the proposal ST/SG/AC.10/C.3/2001/43 was submitted, proposing changes to Special Packing Provision PP1 to remove the labelling and marking requirements for individual containers transported in accordance with this provision, CEPE have received advice that it would be more appropriate to make amendments to Chapters 5.1 and 5.2 to achieve the same purpose. This is because Packing Instructions and associated Special Provisions were designed to deal solely with packaging and should not be confused with other aspects of the Regulations.
2. CEPE understands and endorses this advice, and therefore suggests that their proposal be amended in an appropriate way. The justification remains the same as set out in ST/SG/AC.10/C.3/2001/43.

**Proposals**

3. Add a new paragraph 5.1.2.3 as follows:  
“For UN1133, UN1210, UN1263 and UN1866 of packing groups II or III, individual packagings of 5 litres or less, transported in palletised loads, a pallet box or unit load device, or as an inner packaging of a combination packaging, all in conformity with Special Packing Provision PP1, need not be marked and labelled in accordance with Chapter 5.2.”

4. Add a new paragraph 5.2.1.6 as follows:

*“Special marking provisions for Class 3*

For UN1133, UN1210, UN1263 and UN1866 of packing groups II or III, individual packagings of 5 litres or less, transported in palletised loads, a pallet box or unit load device, or as an inner packaging of a combination packaging, all in conformity with Special Packing Provision PP1, need not be marked.”

5. Add a new paragraph 5.2.2.1.13 as follows:

*“Special provisions for the labelling of packagings of certain flammable liquids*

For UN1133, UN1210, UN1263 and UN1866 of packing groups II or III, individual packagings of 5 litres or less, transported in palletised loads, a pallet box or unit load device, or as an inner packaging of a combination packaging, in conformity with Special Packing Provision PP1, need not be labelled in accordance with this Chapter.”
