Programme

- 9 h 15 a.m.:** Meeting at the bus stop, rue de la paix, next to the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC). Bus ride to Gruyère.
- Lunch in one of the typical Restaurants at your own choice
- Visit to the medieval town of Gruyère. Free time for three hours
- Possibility to visit the old castle **Chateau de Gruyère** ⑥
- Possibility to visit the **Fromagerie** (Cheese factory) ⑥
- 2 h 00 p.m.:** Bus trip to Epesses. Visit of the village and wine tasting in one of the old cellars
- 4 h 00 p.m.:** Walk (downhill, about 30 minutes) across the beautiful landscape above the lake of Geneva to the village of Cully
- 4 h 30 p.m.:** Return by bus from Cully to Geneva
