- 5.1. The secretariat will present an updated list of the Contracting Parties to the Agreement.
- 5.2. WP.29 may wish to consider the organization of the work of its subsidiary Working Parties, with a view to the implementation of the programme of work concerning the 1998 Agreement (TRANS/WP.29/841, paras. 109-112 and annex 4).

6. 1997 AGREEMENT (INSPECTIONS)

6.1. The secretariat will present an updated list of the Contracting Parties to the Agreement.

In this regard, WP.29 may wish to consider the opinion of the EU regarding the competence with respect to the Agreement and its application by the EU Member States (TRANS/WP.29/841, paras. 113 to 115).

Consideration of any other items related to the 1997 Agreement was postponed to the next session of WP.29, at earliest (TRANS/WP.29/841, paras. 116 and 117).

7. OTHER BUSINESS

- 7.1. In view of the general support of the proposals for improvements in the enforcement of type approval and conformity of production procedures (TRANS/WP.29/2002/28), the Administrative Committee (AC.1) of the 1958 Agreement agreed to consider comments and opinions expected to be given on the suggestions and observations that had been tabled during the previous session by the representative of the Russian Federation (informal document No. 8 see TRANS/WP.29/841, para. 120).
- 7.1.1. The Administrative Committee (AC.1) of the 1958 Agreement agreed to examine the ISO Directive for preparation of Standards and consider its application for improving the drafting of ECE Regulations (TRANS/WP.29/841, para. 120(a)).
- 7.1.2. AC.1 and/or WP.29 may wish to explore the idea of setting up an informal system that would provide assistance in resolving interpretation issues concerning ECE Regulations (TRANS/WP.29/841, para. 120(b)).
- 7.1.3. An agreement was reached to study recall procedures applied in various countries, Contracting Parties to the 1958 Agreement, if some relevant information was made available (TRANS/WP.29/841, para. 120(c)).
- 7.1.4. AC.1 agreed to study the electronic database system used in Australia, in order to consider if a similar database could be established for the exchange of information concerning ECE type approvals.
- 7.2. WP.29 agreed to consider a joint proposal by OICA and CLEPA concerning the replacement parts and resolving the question raised by OICA in document TRANS/WP.29/841, paras. 123 and 124).
- 7.3. WP.29 agreed to consider the proposals by OICA concerning type approval marking of vehicular systems. The delegations were invited to study informal document No. 15, distributed during the previous session, and bring their copies of this informal document to the current session, as a base for the discussion (TRANS/WP.29/841, paras. 125-127).

8. ADOPTION OF THE REPORT

In accordance with established practice, WP.29 will adopt the report on its one-hundred-and-twenty-seventh session on the basis of the draft prepared by the secretariat.

The report shall also include sections referring to the

- (i) Twenty-first session of the Administrative Committee (AC.1) of the 1958 Agreement;
- (ii) Fifth session of the Executive Committee (AC.3) of the 1998 Agreement.

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B. <u>Sessions of the Administrative/Executive Committees</u>

1. 1958 AGREEMENT - TWENTY-FIRST SESSION OF AC.1

1.1. ESTABLISHMENT OF THE AC.1

The Administrative Committee shall be composed of all the Contracting Parties in accordance with the rules of procedure set out in Appendix 1 of the 1958 Agreement (E/ECE/324-E/ECE/TRANS/505/Rev.2, Article 1, para. 2).

1.2. DRAFT AMENDMENTS TO EXISTING REGULATIONS - VOTING BY AC.1

Amendments to Regulations shall be established by the Administrative Committee according to the procedure indicated in Appendix 1. Proposed amendments to Regulations shall be put to the vote. Each country, Contracting Party to the Agreement applying the Regulation, shall have one vote. A quorum of not less than half of the Contracting Parties applying the Regulation is required for the purposes of taking decisions. For the determination of the quorum, regional economic integration organizations, being Contracting Parties to the Agreement, vote with the number of votes of their Member States. The representative of a regional economic integration organization may deliver the votes of those of its constituent sovereign countries, which apply the Regulation. Draft amendments to Regulations shall be established by a two-thirds majority of those present and voting (Article 12 and Appendix 1).

Contracting Parties experiencing difficulties in attending the sessions of the Administrative Committee AC.1 might be allowed exceptionally to express their views on items considered in writing, or by delegation of their voting power to other Contracting Parties attending the session (TRANS/WP.29/482, para. 11).

If all Contracting Parties to the Agreement agree, any Regulation adopted under the terms of the unamended Agreement may be treated as though it was a Regulation adopted under the terms of the amended Agreement (Article 15, para. 3).

1.4. NEW DRAFT REGULATIONS - VOTING BY AC.1

The Contracting Parties shall establish, through an Administrative Committee made up of all the Contracting Parties in conformity with the rules of procedure set out in Appendix 1 and on the basis of the following articles and paragraphs, Regulations for wheeled vehicles, equipment and parts which can be fitted and/or be used on wheeled vehicles (Article 1, para. 1).

Proposed new Regulations shall be put to the vote. Each country, Contracting Party to the Agreement, shall have one vote. A quorum consisting of not less than one-half of the Contracting Parties to the Agreement is required for the purpose of taking decisions. For the determination of the quorum, regional economic integration organizations, being Contracting Parties to the Agreement, vote with the number of votes of their Member States. The representative of a regional economic integration organization may deliver the votes of its constituent sovereign countries. New Draft Regulations shall be established by a two-thirds majority of those present and voting (Appendix 1, Article 5).

- 2.1. OPEN MEETING
- 2.1.1. AC.3 may wish to review the progress of work on the proposals for candidate global technical regulations, following the adoption of the programme of work and establishing of work priorities during the previous session (TRANS/WP.29/841, paras. 109-112, 159-167 and annex 4).
- 2.1.2. AC.3 is expected to consider the proposal by Canada for amending the guidelines regarding proposing and developing global technical regulations (TRANS/WP.29/841, para. 169).
- 2.1.3. AC.3 may wish to resume its consideration of the proposed format of global technical regulations (TRANS/WP.29/2002/25), if necessary (TRANS/WP.29/841, paras. 170-173).
- 2.1.4. Discussion of any other issues, as appropriate.
- 2.1. CLOSED MEETING
- 2.1.1. The Contracting Parties to the Agreement are expected to resume consideration of the questions related to the operation and implementation of the Agreement.
- 2.2.2. AC.3 might wish to consider any actions by the Contracting Parties, with a view to achieving effective functions of the Agreement.
