1. This paragraph is very important for the people in the sectors of transport and logistics.

For purpose of users friendly I would like to suggest that the paragraph 1.4.10.4.2.2. should be moved to 1.4.10.2 as the general provision.

That is:

1.4.10.2 General provisions

1.4.10.2.1 For transport, .....(existing paragraph 1.4.10.4.2.2 ).

2. Accordingly, existing paragraph 1.4.10.2 and followings should renumbered.

3. "new health hazard symbol" in (c) of paragraph 1.4.10.5.3.1 should read "health hazard symbol".
