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PROPOSAL FOR DRAFT SUPPLEMENT 2 TO REGULATION No. 60

(Driver-operated controls)

A. PROPOSAL

Paragraph 6.2.2.2.1., amend to read:

"6.2.2.2.1. Vehicles equipped with riding pedals must, and vehicles equipped with a platform or with footrests integrated into a platform may, conform to the requirement."

Position of control: on handlebars: left side forward

Type of control: hand lever

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B. JUSTIFICATION

- 1. Large-sized scooters equipped with a handlebar type rear brake and having a maximum design speed exceeding 100 km/h are already on sale and widely accepted in the European market.
- 2. A handlebar rear brake has a braking capacity equivalent with that of a foot-pedal type of rear brake throughout the entire speed range including the speeds exceeding 100 km/h.
