B.1.1. <u>Regulation No. 14</u> (Safety-belt anchorages)

GRSP agreed to consider an updated proposal for effective anchorages by Spain, if available. GRSP may wish to consider a proposal by Japan (jointly with informal document No. 15 of the thirty-second session 4/) for the introduction of mandatory equipment of a three-point safety-belt in the rear outboard seats of N1 vehicles, a proposal by OICA to better define the loading during tests, and a proposal from the secretariat to align the prescriptions of the Regulation to those of Regulation No. 16.
