MISCELLANEOUS PROPOSALS OF AMENDMENTS TO THE MODEL REGULATIONS  
ON THE TRANSPORT OF DANGEROUS GOODS

Amendment to Special Provision 191

Transmitted by the expert from Austria

**Introduction**

1. Special Provision 191 is assigned to UN 2037, RECEPTACLES, SMALL, CONTAINING GAS (GAS CARTRIDGES). The special provision in its current version contains an exemption, which reads as follows: "Receptacles with a capacity not exceeding 50 ml containing only non-toxic constituents are not subject to these Regulations".
2. In documents ST/SG/AC.10/C.3/2002/57 and UN/SCETDG/24/INF.12 the expert from Austria with regard to the capacity limit in Special Provision 191 stated on one hand why this limit should be increased to 120 ml and supported on the other hand to restrict the scope of the exemption to receptacles containing not only non-toxic but also non-flammable constituents. He also explained why in his view the first sentence of the current version of Special Provision 191 should not be kept.
3. Based on this, the expert from Austria would like to propose formally what was contained in INF.12.

**Proposal**

4. Amend Special Provision 191 to read as follows:

"191 Receptacles, small, containing gas with a capacity not exceeding 120 ml containing no constituents subject to these Regulations other than a Division 2.2 gas are not subject to these Regulations."
