1/ The forty-seventh session was initially scheduled to be held from 13 to 16 January 2004. However, during its last session (TRANS/WP.29/GRPE/46, para. 58), GRPE decided to start the session on Monday, 12 January 2004 with the informal meetings, without interpretation. These modifications to the agenda are subject to confirmation by WP.29 at its one-hundred-and-thirty-first session in November 2003. Full interpretation will only be provided from Tuesday afternoon to Friday morning.
