EIGA welcomes the new approach by Portugal and the IRU on sale on delivery and hopes that this proposal will allay the misgivings of several authorities. The process of distributing to small volume users who may or may not have previously placed an order occurs in our industry when supplying the medical, beverage dispense and small fabrication (e.g. repair shops) sectors of our markets. There is therefore a need to add additional Class 2 substances to the list given in the proposal in TRANS/WP.15/2005/19.

EIGA proposes that the proposed special provision 6XY is also inserted in column 6 of Table A against the following entries.
