

PROPOSAL FOR CORRIGENDUM 1 TO DRAFT SUPPLEMENT 2
TO REGULATION No. 92

(Replacement exhaust silencing systems (RESS) for motorcycles)

Transmitted by the Secretariat

A. PROPOSAL

The new paragraph 6.5., correct to read (deleting the reference to national regulations):

"6.5. Evaluation of the emission of pollutants of vehicles equipped with replacement silencer system

The vehicle referred to in paragraph 3.3.3., equipped with a replacement exhaust silencing system (RESS) of the type for which approval is requested, shall fulfil the pollution requirements ~~of national regulations~~ in force at the time the vehicle was type approved. The results of these tests shall be documented in the test report."

B. JUSTIFICATION

GRB adopted during its fortieth session an amendment to Regulation No. 92 in order to ensure that the replacement silencing systems should fulfil not only the requirements for the noise level, but also those for the emissions of gaseous pollutants laid down in Regulation No. 40 (TRANS/WP.29/GRB/38, para. 29).

WP.29 adopted that proposal (TRANS/WP.29/2005/6) during its one-hundred-and-thirty-fifth session (TRANS/WP.29/1039, para. 66). However, WP.29 requested GRB to prepare a correction to Regulation No. 92 eliminating the reference to national regulations.

For that purpose, the secretariat has prepared the above mentioned correction to the Regulation No. 92.
