The Working Party on Passive Safety (GRSP) ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRSP/39, agreed to have a final review of the draft gtr on paras. 3-8 the basis of a revised document prepared by the ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRSP/2006/2 informal group and a proposal of the final ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRSP/2006/7 report by European Commission on this subject.
