2. Updating of the second revised edition of the Globally Harmonized System of Classification and Labelling of Chemicals (GHS)

(a) Physical hazards

(b) Health hazards

The representative of the OECD may wish to inform the Sub-Committee about the on-going work on the development of a proposal for the classification of strong versus weak sensitizers.

(c) Environmental hazards

The Sub-committee of experts will be informed about the progress of work on: the development of classification and labelling criteria for chemicals hazardous for the terrestrial environment and for ozone depleting chemicals; the proposal for the revision of Chapter 4.1; and, the validation of the protocol on transformation/dissolution of metals and metal compounds in aqueous media.

(d) Annexes

Following the mandate given by the Sub-Committee of experts at its twelfth session (see ST/SG/AC.10/C.4/24, par. 20 and 21), the expert from the United Kingdom will inform the Sub-committee of the preliminary results of the discussions of the correspondence group on the revision of annexes 1, 2 and 3 regarding their scope, contents and the target audiences to whom they should be addressed.
