

Request related to Regulation N. 67

Transmitted by the expert from AEGPL

Based on the report of the Working Party on Pollution and Energy on its fifty-third session, Agenda item 10.2. paragraph 39:

“GRPE acknowledged that this issue was not related to pollution and energy, and agreed on the need to seek the advice of WP.29 on this issue, and more generally on how to deal with specific safety regulations related to the use of alternative fuels (LPG, CNG, electric power, etc.).”

AEGPL encourages the WP29 during its next sessions to allow a clear debate on the move of Regulation No. 67, concerning the safety of the LPG components and systems, from the GRPE to another expert group.

Regulation No. 67 has successful been managed for years by GRPE experts who have accumulated knowledge in safety aspects regarding alternative fuels storage and feeding systems.

Given the particularities associated with Regulation No. 67, we are concerned about the possible loss of expertise and the complication or delay of work that has thus far been carried out with a high degree of competence.

We would therefore suggest further reflection on this matter.
