#### **I Introduction**

1. In the Recommendations on the Transport of Dangerous Goods (Model Regulations) thirteenth revised edition (ST/SG/AC.10/1/Rev.13) in Figure 2.4.1: FLOW CHART SCHEME FOR SELF-REACTIVE SUBSTANCES in Box 1 is the question “Does it propagate a detonation?”. In the Recommendations on the Transport of Dangerous Goods (Model Regulations), fourteenth revised edition (ST/SG/AC.10/1/Rev.14) this question was changed to the wrong phrase “Does it propagate a deflagration?”. In the opinion of the expert from Germany this change was done by mistake because in the Document ST/SG/AC.10/34/Add.1 REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE OF EXPERTS ON ITS THIRD SESSION (Geneva, 14 December 2006), Addendum, Annex 1, Amendments to the Recommendations on the Transport of Dangerous Goods (Model Regulations) no amendments concerning the Figure 2.4.1 were found. In the fifteenth revised edition of the Recommendations on the Transport of Dangerous Goods (Model Regulations) (ST/SG/AC.10/1/Rev.15) and in the Draft corrigendum to the English version of the 15th revised edition of the Model Regulations (UN/SCETDG/31/INF.39) the wrong phrase was left unchanged.

#### **II Proposal**

2. The expert from Germany proposes to amend the phrase in Box 1 of Figure 2.4.1 to read as: “Does it propagate a detonation?”.
