LISTING, CLASSIFICATION AND PACKING

Requirements Applicable to UN 3277

Transmitted by the International Air Transport Association (IATA)

Introduction

1. It has recently been brought to the attention of IATA that there appears to be an inconsistency with respect to the application of Special Provision 274 for UN 3277, CHLOROFORMATES, TOXIC, CORROSIVE, N.O.S.
2. The entry in the dangerous goods list for UN 3277 has Special Provision 274 assigned in column 6 to identify that for the purposes of documentation and package marking the proper shipping name shall be supplemented with the technical name.
3. However, the related entries, UN 2742, CHLOROFORMATES, TOXIC, CORROSIVE, FLAMMABLE, N.O.S., UN 3361, CHLOROSILANES, TOXIC, CORROSIVE, N.O.S. and UN 3362, CHLOROSILANES, TOXIC, CORROSIVE, FLAMMABLE, N.O.S. do not have Special Provision 274 assigned.

Proposal

4. The Subcommittee is invited to consider if Special Provision 274 should be removed from UN 3277, or alternatively if SP 274 should be assigned to UN 2742, UN 3361 and UN 3362.
