#### ANNEX 4 OF ATP

##### Regulations on fresh fruit and vegetables transportation

##### temperature conditions to be assured during transportation of fresh fruit and vegetables

During transportation, the temperature of indicated fruits and vegetables should be the in following range:

Apricots, oranges, thick-skinned water melons, cherries, grapes, pears of late ripeness, grapefruits, pomegranates early-ripe food potatoes, white cabbage (early-ripe, mid-season), cauliflower, vegetable marrows, gooseberries, onions, table carrots, mandarins, peaches, red beet without leaves, plum, currants beans, garlic, late-ripe apples	From +2 to +5°C
Pineapples, aubergines, melons, lemons, open soil cucumbers, tomatoes of rosy ripeness	From +6 to 9°C
Tomatoes of milky ripeness	From +11 to 13°C

In case the temperature of fresh fruit and vegetables needs to be checked, the regulation provided in annex 2, appendix 2 of ATP <sup>x)</sup> applies.

x) In the case of the adoption of Annex 4 (Regulation on fresh fruit and vegetables transportation), the modifications to annex 2, appendix 2 of ATP shall be made.

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
