## Correction to table 1.5.1 (Chapter 1.5)

Transmitted by the expert from Sweden

### Introduction

1. There is a slight inconsistency in the GHS with regard to the mixtures generic cut-off value for relevant ingredients for Hazardous to the aquatic environment (0.1% for Category 1 ingredients) in Chapter 4, and the generic cut-off values for providing a Safety Data Sheet table in Chapter 1.5.
2. While the generic cut-off value for relevant ingredients was changed to 0.1% (see paragraph 4.1.3.1.), no change was made in terms of the cut-off for providing an SDS table in Chapter 1.5. These should be the same.

### Proposal

3. For consistency, replace the row for Hazardous to the aquatic environment in table 1.5.1 (Chapter 1.5 of the GHS) with the following:

Hazard class	Cut-off value/concentration limit
Hazardous to the aquatic environment (Category Acute 1)	$\geq 0.1\%$
Hazardous to the aquatic environment (Category Chronic 1)	$\geq 0.1\%$
Hazardous to the aquatic environment (Categories Chronic 2, 3 and 4)	$\geq 1.0\%$
