### Use of aluminium in EX/III vehicle bodies

#### Transmitted by the Government of France<sup>1</sup>

- 1. Chapter 9.3 of ADR sets out requirements for EX/II or EX/III vehicles intended for the carriage of explosive substances and articles (Class 1) in packages.
- 2. The materials to be used in the construction of vehicle bodies are covered by 9.3.1, which specifies that:
  - "No materials likely to form dangerous compounds with the explosive substances carried shall be used in the construction of the body."
- 3. In our view, this requirement does not allow for the use of aluminium in the construction of EX/II and EX/III vehicle bodies.
- 4. We should like to know the view of the Working Party on this issue.
