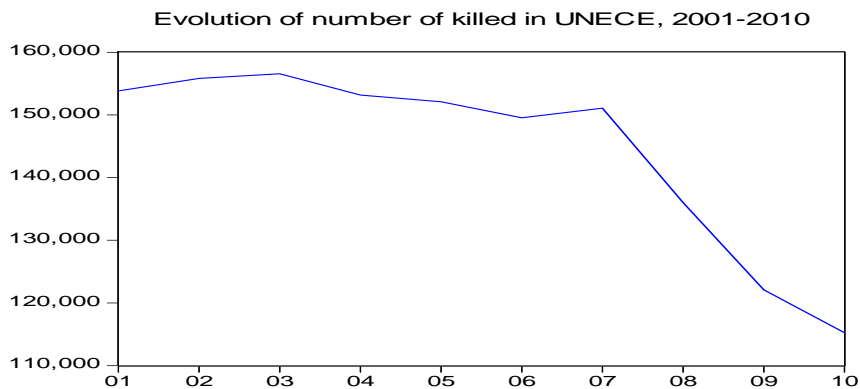

EVOLUTION OF ROAD SAFETY IN UNECE REGION

1. Number of road fatalities decreased by -5.6% in 2010

In 2010, the total number of killed in road traffic accidents decreased in the UNECE Region compared to its level in 2009. The decrease reached -5.6% confirming the good results of 2008 and 2009 (-10%). The total number of killed is about 115'242 in 2010 (153'850 in 2001).

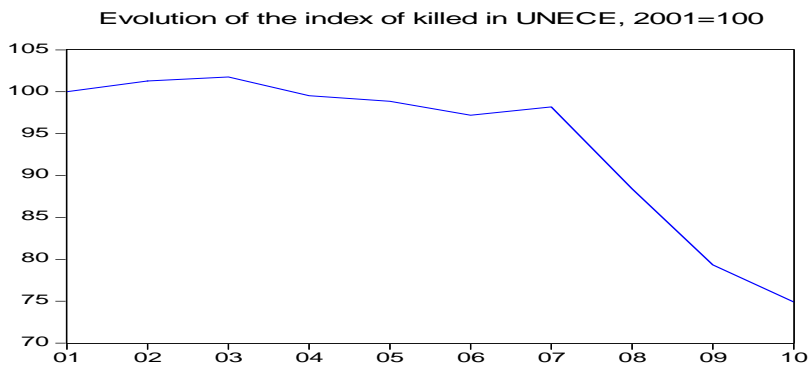

Considering the long-term trends and taking the year 2001 as base (2001=100), the index of fatalities for the UNECE region reached 74.9 in 2010 (passing for the first time under 75). Therefore, the total decrease is about -25.1% in this decade.

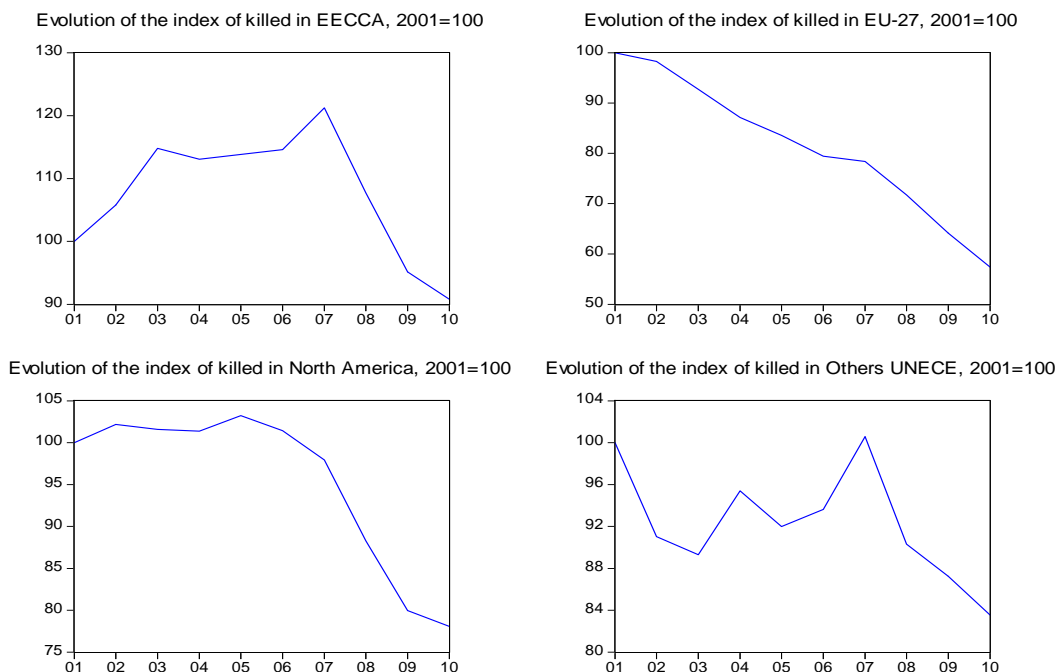

This improvement is very different from country to country and from one sub-region to another.

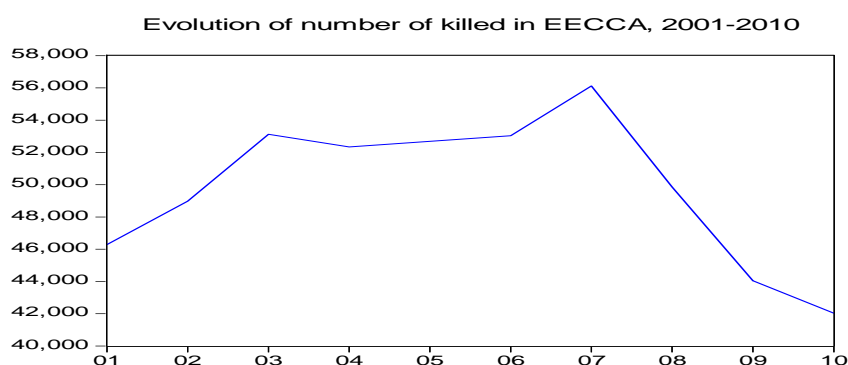

Over the decade, the best performance is for EU-27 with an important decrease (-42.6 %) followed by North America (-21.9 %), Others UNECE¹ (-16.4 %) and the countries of Eastern Europe, Central Asia and South Caucasus (EECCA)² with a small decrease (-9.2 %).

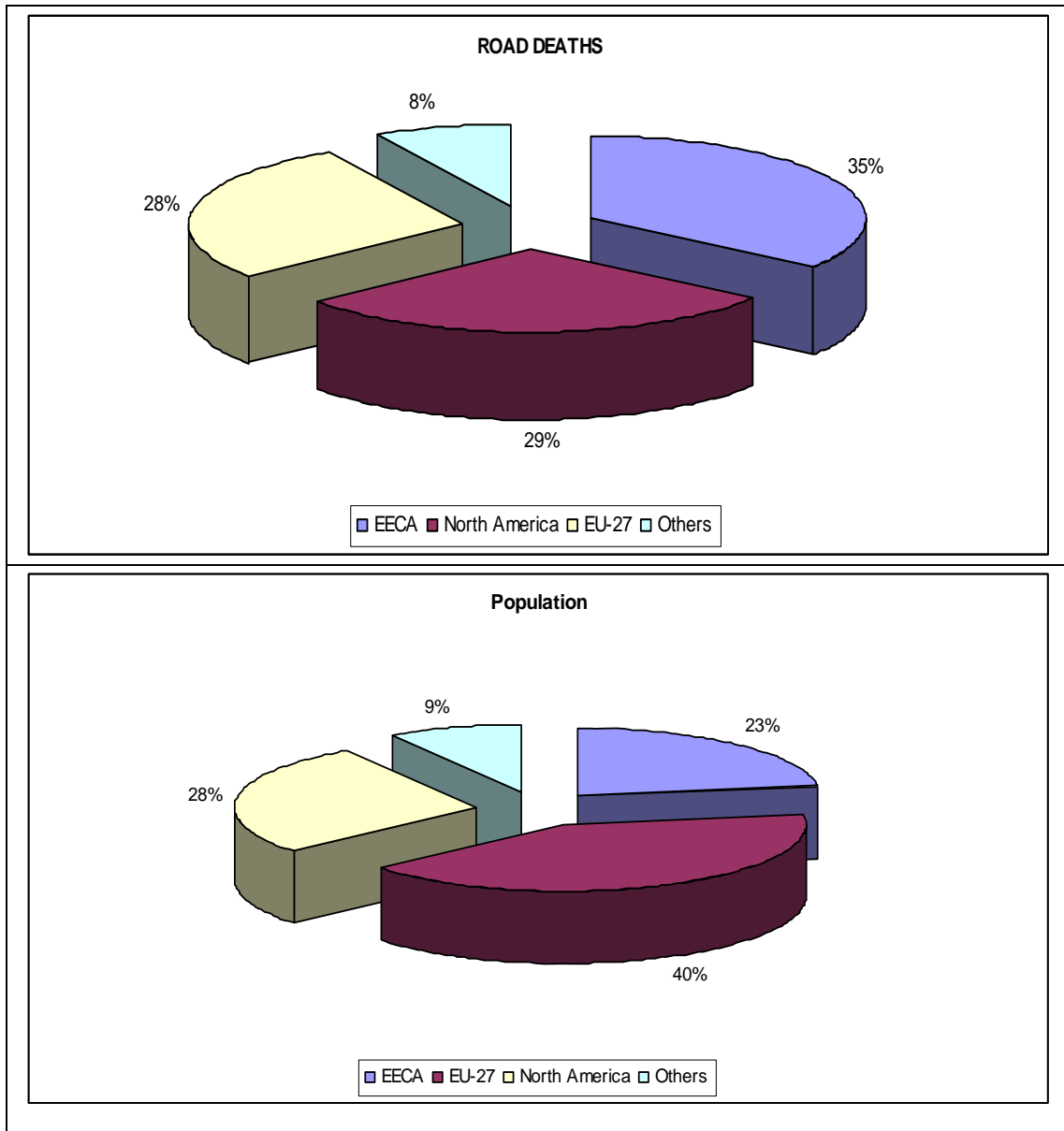

EECCA Countries represent 35% of the fatalities in 2009 for only 23 % of the total of population, lagging behind EU-27 and North America with respectively 28 % and 29% of road deaths for 28 % and 40 % of population.

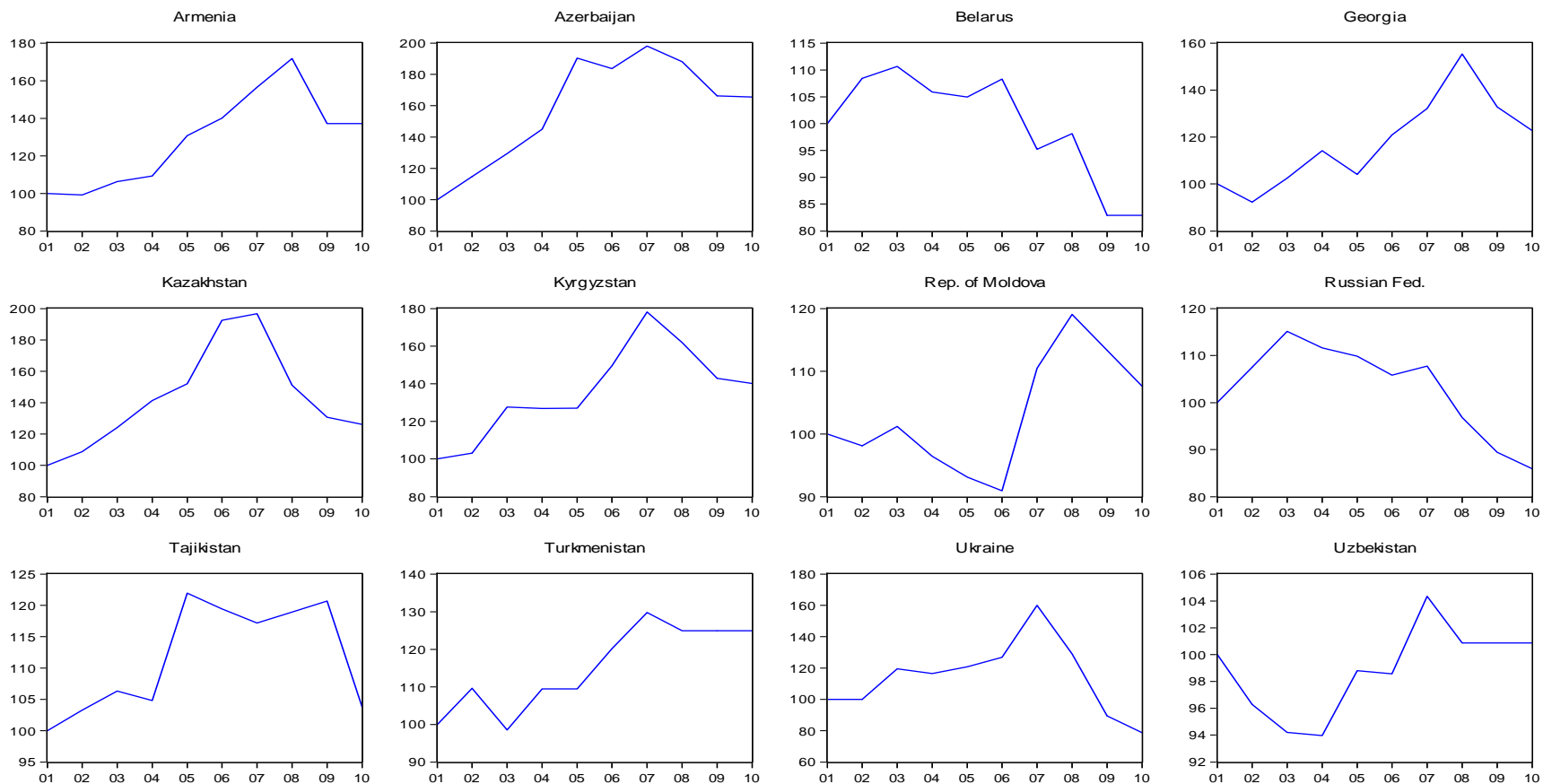
Figure 5: REPARTITION OF ROAD DEATHS AND POPULATION³ BETWEEN UNECE SUB-REGIONS, 2009

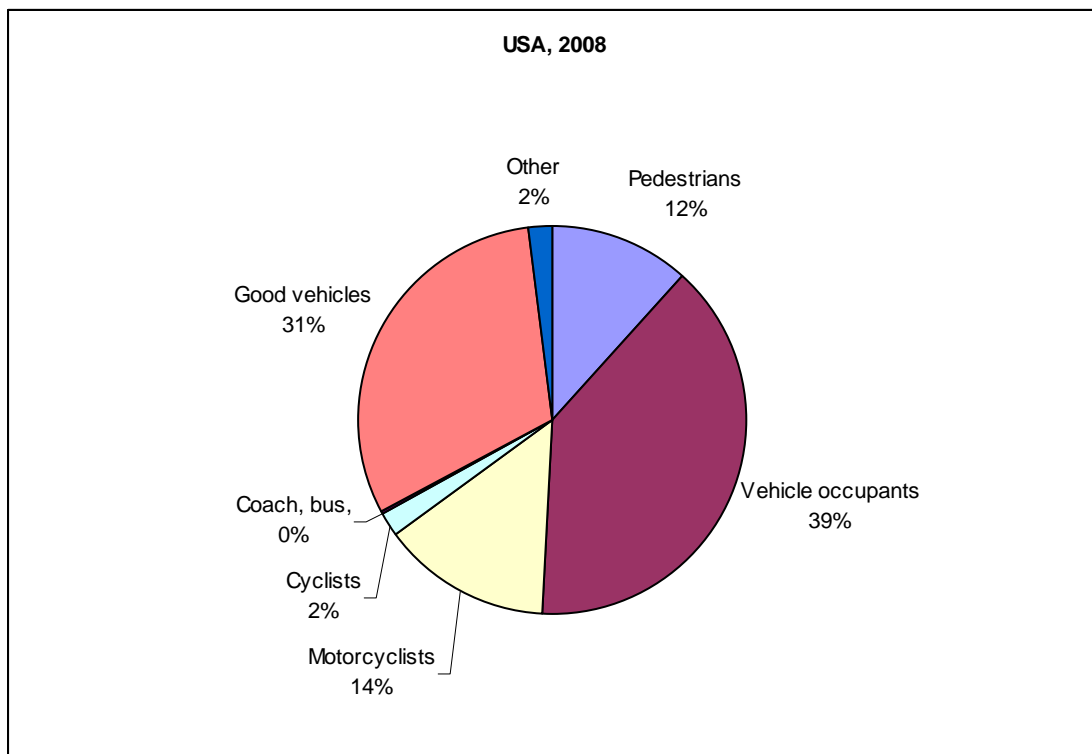
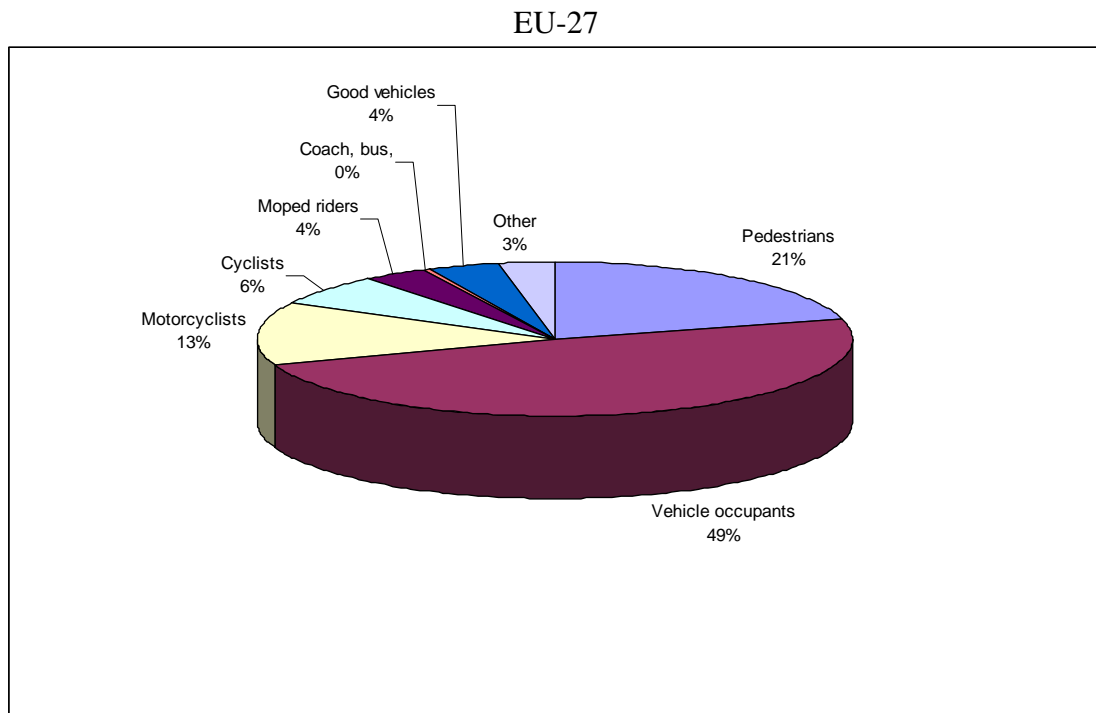
Figure 6: EVOLUTION OF THE INDEX OF KILLED IN ROAD ACCIDENTS, IN EACH EECCA COUNTRY (2001=100)

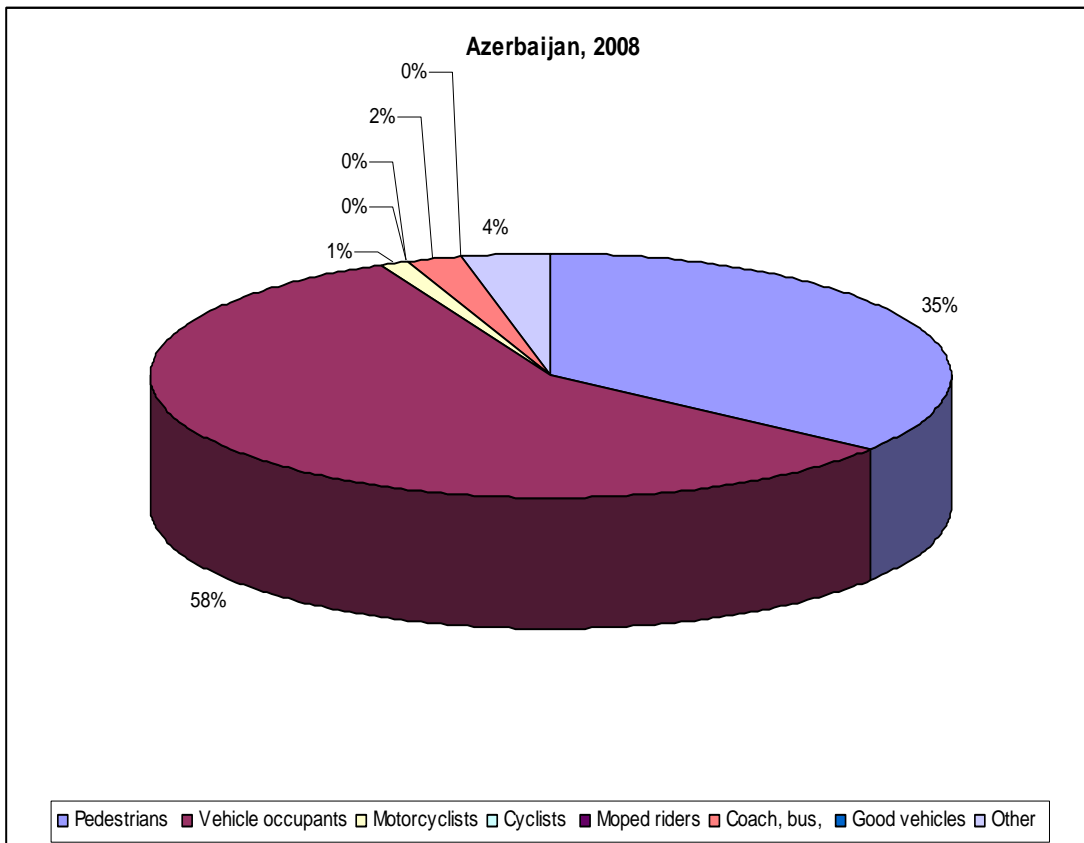
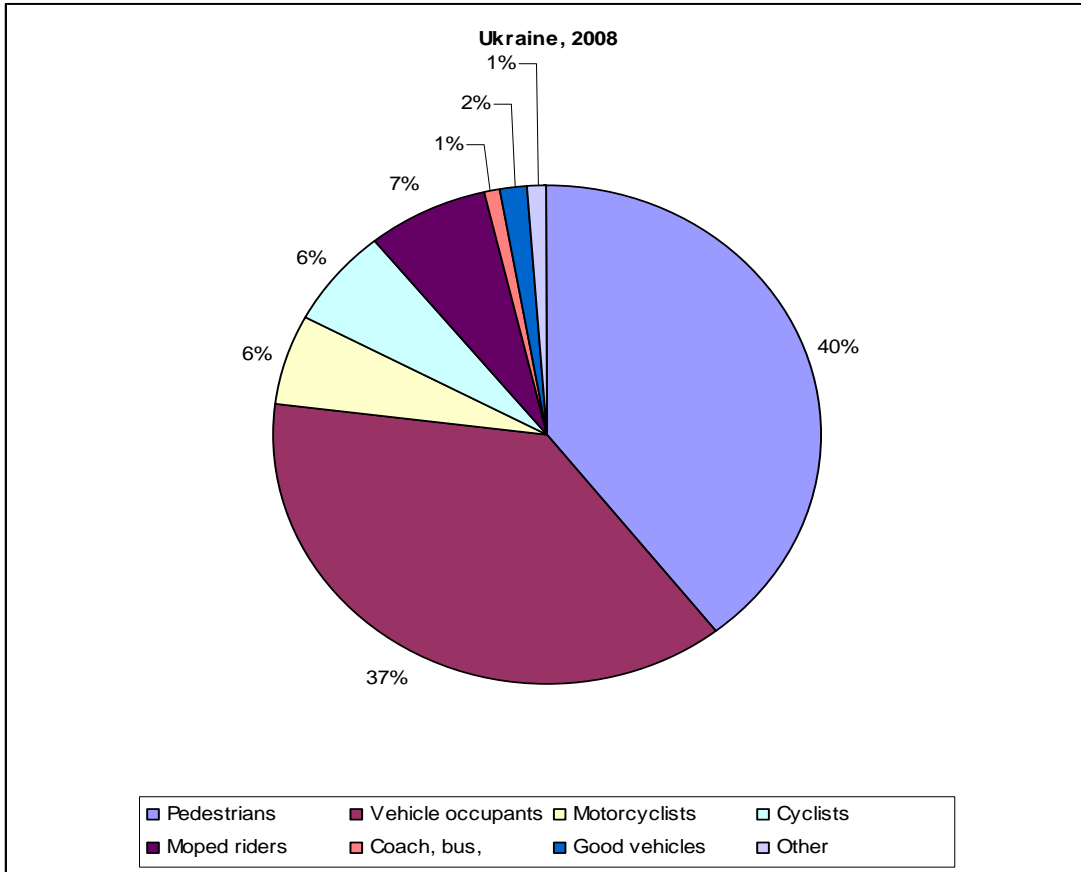

In EU-27, almost half of killed in road traffic accidents in 2008 are vehicle occupants, followed by pedestrians (21%), motorized 2-wheelers (17%), bicyclists (6%), good vehicles (4%) and others (3%).

Figure 7: REPARTITION OF ROAD DEATHS BY ROAD USER IN SELECTED COUNTRIES, 2008



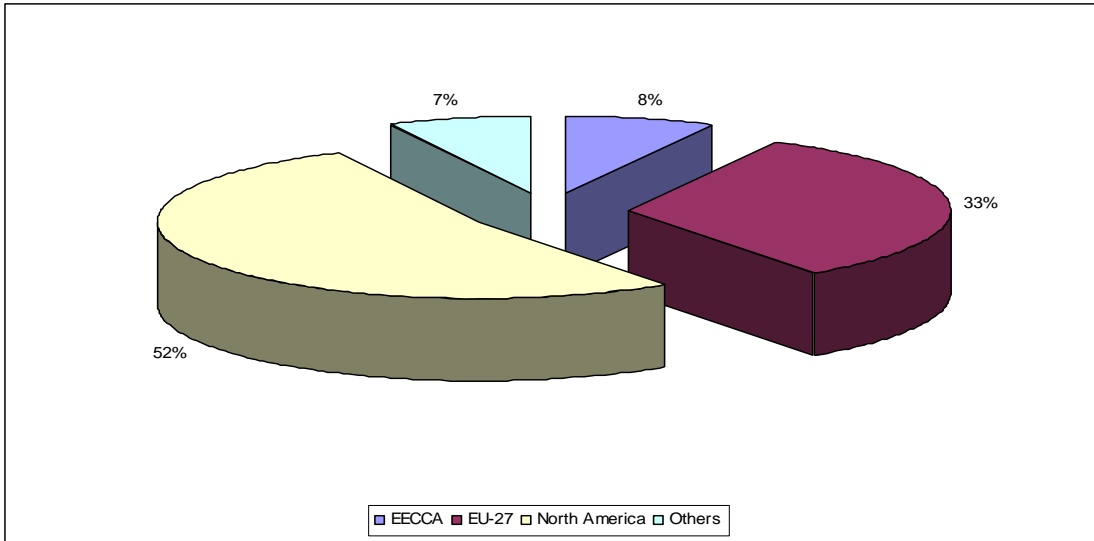

2. Number of injured in road traffic accidents decreased only by -1.2% in 2010

In 2010, the number of road injuries decreased slightly (-1.2 %) compared to 2009 (EU-27: -4.6 %, EECA: -3.5 %, North America: +1.1% and Others UNECE: +0.4 %).

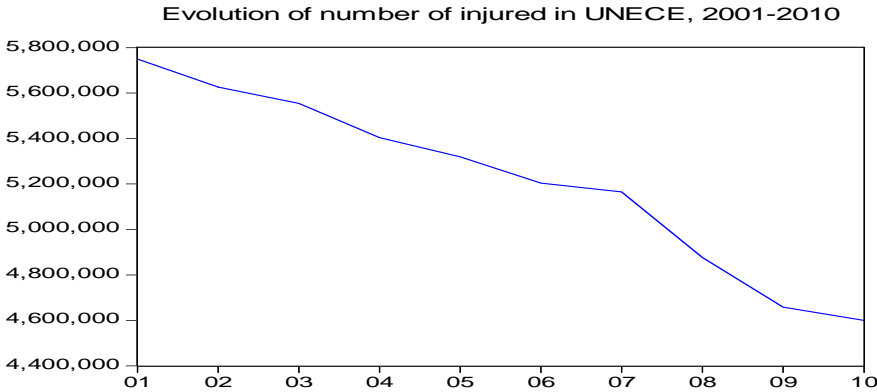
Figure 8: REPARTITION OF NUMBER OF INJURED IN ROAD TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS BETWEEN UNECE SUB-REGIONS, 2010

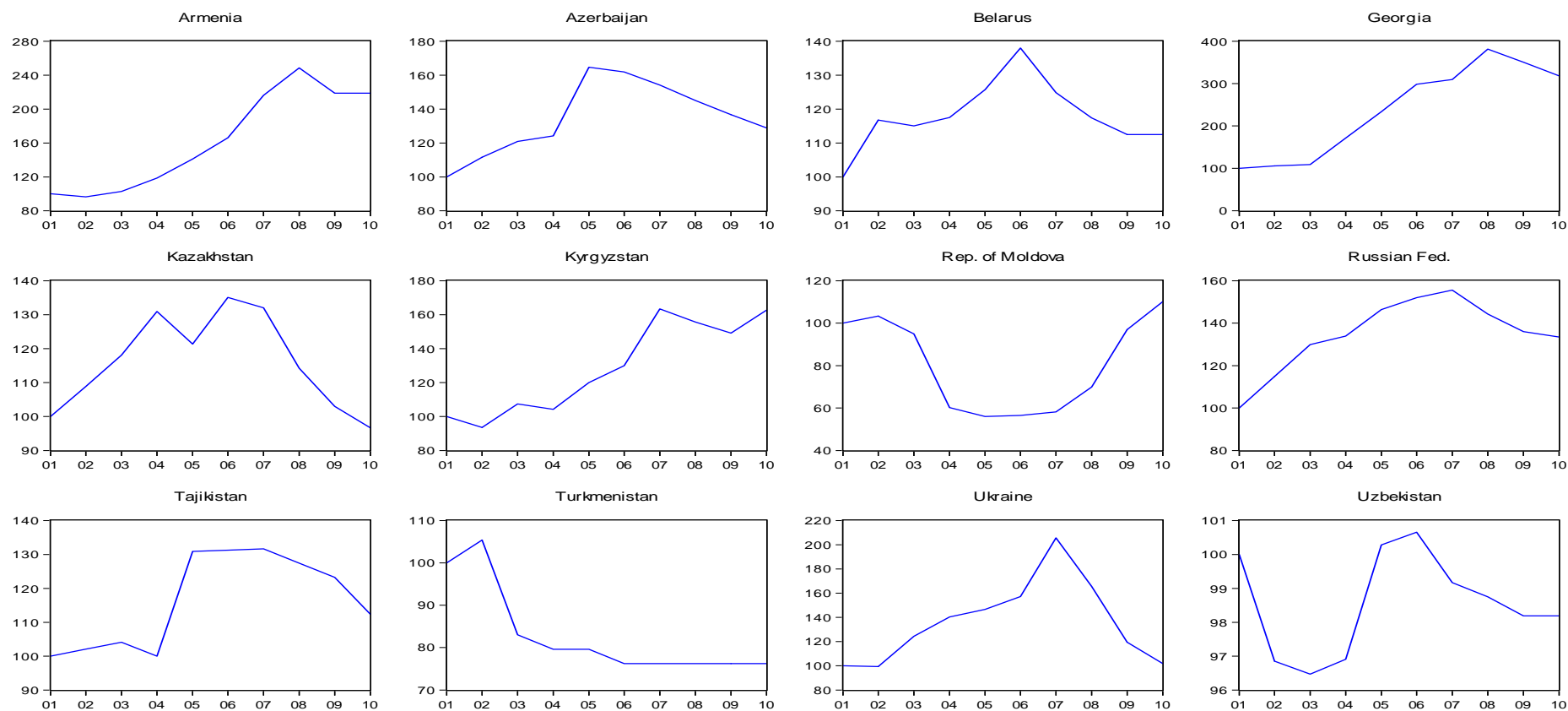
Considering the long term evolution, the number of road traffic injuries decreased considerably (-20 %) in the UNECE region passing from 5'749'563 in 2001 to 4'599'794 in 2010. However in some countries, the number of injured increased considerably for the same period in particular in EECCA Countries and some others UNECE (see Table 2 annexed).

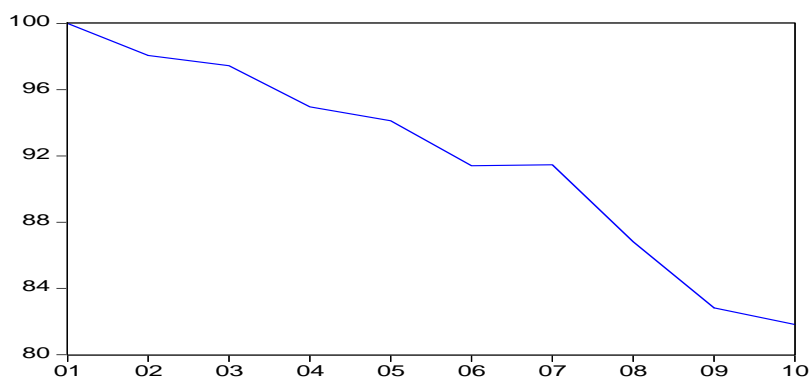
3. Number of injury road accidents decreased by -3.9% in 2009

In 2010, the number of road traffic accidents with injuries decreased by -1.2% compared to its level in 2009.

Considering the long term evolution, the number of injury road traffic accidents decreased by -18.2% in the UNECE region passing from 4'045'871 in 2001 to 3'310'489 in 2010. In some countries, this indicator increased considerably during the same period (see Table 3 annexed).

Evolution of the index of injury road accidents in UNECE, 2001=100

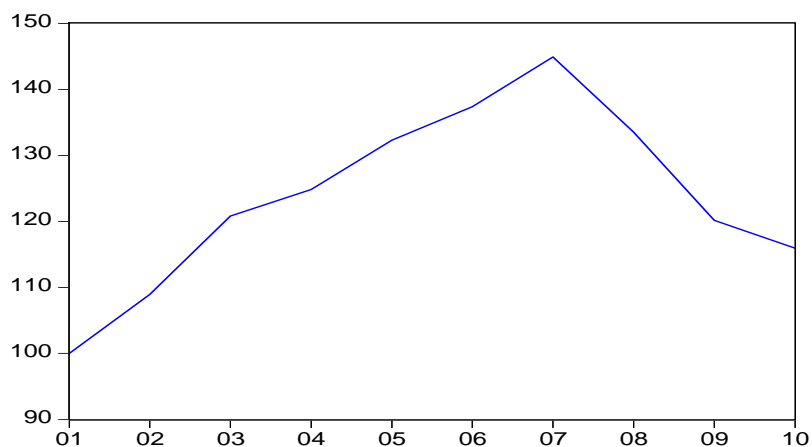
