Proposal for Supplement 7 to the 01 series of amendments

Submitted by the expert from the Working Party "Brussels 1952"*

The text reproduced below was prepared by the expert from the Working Party "Brussels 1952" (GTB) to clarify the requirements concerning the number of test samples. The modifications to the existing text of the Regulation are marked in bold for new or strikethrough for deleted characters.

* In accordance with the programme of work of the Inland Transport Committee for 2010–2014 (ECE/TRANS/208, para. 106, ECE/TRANS/2010/8, programme activity 02.4), the World Forum will develop, harmonize and update Regulations in order to enhance the performance of vehicles. The present document is submitted in conformity with that mandate.

I. Proposal

Paragraph 3.3.5., amend to read:

"3.3.5 ~~A sample~~ **For each type of headlamp, one sample intended for the installation on the left side of the vehicle and one sample intended for the installation of the right side of the vehicle,** complete with relevant headlamp(s) installed as described in paragraph 3.3 1., either on (a) suitable test fixture(s) or on (a) vehicle(s) representative of the type(s) to be approved, in such a manner as to allow normal operation of the cleaner and the headlamp(s). **In the case of headlamps for right hand traffic and left hand traffic, it is sufficient to test only one set of headlamps for either right hand traffic or for left hand traffic;**"

II. Justification

This proposal is intended to clarify the requirements related to the number and nature of the samples to be submitted for type approval with the objective of unifying the procedures in the relevant technical services.
