ST/SG/AC.10/C.4/2015/6 (SAAMI) GHS Classification of explosives

Explosives and related matters will be considered under agenda item 2. It is expected that the TDG Sub-Committee entrust the discussion of the documents under these agenda item to the Working Group on Explosives, which is expected to meet in parallel.

GHS Sub-Committee delegates interested in participating in the work of the TDG Sub-Committee on these issues should register for both (TDG and GHS sub-committee) sessions.
