**Transmitted by the Government of the United Kingdom**

1. During consideration of Belgium's INF.12 and Switzerland's INF. 21 on additive devices, including the necessary training provisions, the United Kingdom noticed that the last sentence of 1.8.3.13 will no longer be valid for ADR 2015 onwards. This is because it refers to dangerous goods safety adviser certificates issued before 1 January 2009, which can remain valid for no more than 5 years.

**Proposal**

Delete the last sentence of 1.8.3.13 beginning 'Certificates of training as safety advisers...'
