1.2.1 Definition of “Liquefied natural gas (LNG)” in the German version

Request

1. In section 1.2.1 of the German version, amend the definition of “Liquefied natural gas (LNG)” as follows and insert a new footnote (text to delete in ~~strikeout~~, new text underlined):

“Flüssigerdgas (LNG)” **: Erdgas (überwiegend Methan, CH₄), das ~~zur einfachen Lagerung oder Beförderung~~ unter Abkühlung verflüssigt wurde.”

“ Die Buchstaben “LNG” sind die Abkürzung des englischen Ausdrucks “Liquified Natural Gas”.”**
