Amendment No 2

to Memorandum of Understanding No (JRC) 31328

The current Memorandum of Understanding between UNECE, European Commission (DG MOVE) and Joint Research Centre (JRC) expires on 30 June 2015. The MoU recognizes the JRC as the AETR authority for root certification and for interoperability certification for the non-EU Contracting Parties to the AETR. This informal document provides an amendment proposal to extend the validity of the MoU until 30 June 2017.

The European Commission, represented for the purpose of signing this Amendment by **Stefan LECHNER**, Director of the IPSC Institute for Protection and Security of the Citizen of the Joint Research Centre, and by Fotis Karamitsos, Director for Logistics, Maritime and Land Transport and Passenger Rights of Directorate-General for Mobility and Transport, duly entitled to sign,

and

Having regard to the Memorandum of Understanding No (JRC)31328, and its Supplement, concluded between the European Commission (EC) and United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE)

THE SIDES HAVE AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1

To extend the duration of the above Memorandum of Understanding by further **24** months, from 01 July 2015 to 30 June 2017.

Article 2

The Memorandum of Understanding is amended as follows:

In Article 3, paragraph 2 is replaced by the following:
