## Specification of hazard labels and marks

**Submitted by the International Air Transport Association (IATA)**

### Proposal

1. Based on the discussion of INF.17, the following is proposed to remove reference to the line on hazard labels being a minimum of 2 mm thick and also to provide some tolerance for the distance from the line forming the diamond on hazard labels being 5 mm to the edge of the label.

5.2.2.2.1.1.2 The label shall be in the form of a square set at an angle of 45 degrees (diamond-shaped). The minimum dimensions shall be 100 mm x 100 mm. ~~and the minimum width of the~~ There shall be a line inside the edge forming the diamond ~~shall be 2 mm. The line inside the edge which~~ shall be parallel and [approximately] 5 mm from the outside of that line to the edge of the label.
