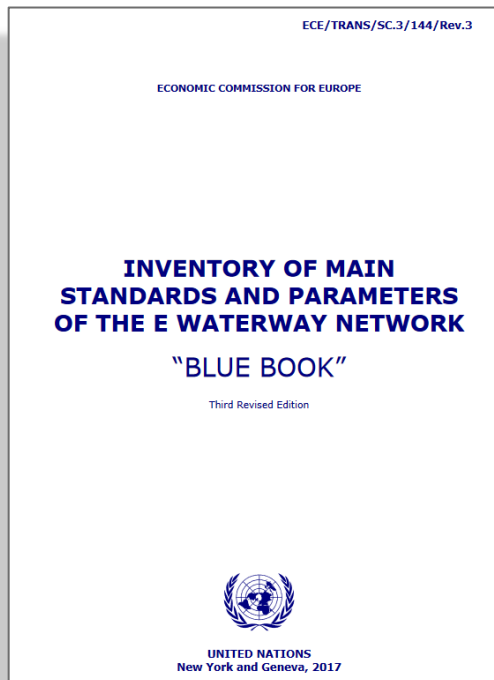

AGN update: a living document

AGN updates and third revision of the Blue Book adopted by SC.3 in November 2016 (ECE/TRANS/SC.3/144/Rev.3)



Main data updates since 2nd revision:

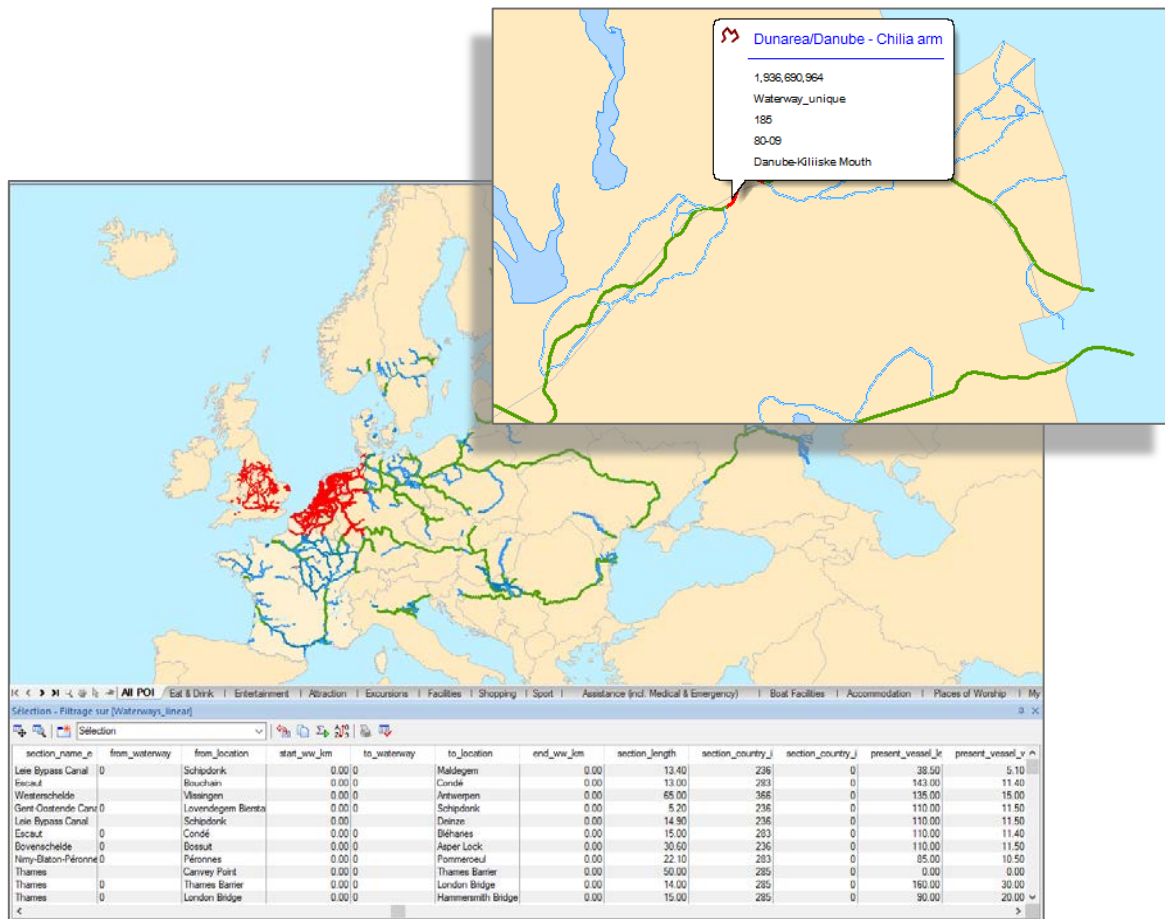
Waterways: about 15 branches edited (E 60, E 91)
Ports: about 40 ports added (Italy, Slovakia, Czech Republic, Netherlands...)

**Additional updates (SC.3 2017 session)
(ECE/TRANS/SC.3/2017/3):**

Modifications on E 40, E80, E 90 branches



Work accomplished



90% of the updates have been processed by the consultant

Improvements: from/to fields added, better accuracy (geographic accuracy, waterway kilometers)

Still missing:

- Tisa river (downstream)
- Danube-Oder-Elbe link
- other links (France)
- Douro river
- some Scottish estuaries
