Directorate as Railway Market Regulator

The main role of Directorate is to provide for fair and non-discriminatory access to the railway infrastructure and rail related services



Directorate as Railway Market Regulator

- Appeal body
- Ex officio
- Market monitoring
- Decision is final and binding
- Administrative enforcement of its decisions
- Authorised to request information

Directorate as National Safety Authority

National body entrusted with the tasks regarding railway safety and railway interoperability



Directorate as National Safety Authority

- Safety certificatation of railway undertakings
- Safety authorisation of infrastructure manager
- Authorisation for placing in service of vehicles
- Authorisation for types of vehicles
- Authorisation for placing in service of structural subsystems
- Certification of train drivers
- Certification of Entities in Charge of Maintenance
- Certificiation of maintenance workshops



Directorate as National Safety Authority

- Audits and checks
- National vehicle register
- Adoption of by-laws in the field of safety and interoperability of rail transport

Directorate as Licensing Authority

- Licensing of railway undertakings
- Checking



Passenger rights

- Handling passenger complaints
- Ex officio
- Opinions and recommendations
- Decisions



Opening of the rail transport market in Serbia

- National railway market is liberalized for the railway undertakings established in Serbia
- In 2019. 10 railway undertakings on the network (2 incumbents, 5 new entrants for freight transport and 3 for transport for its own needs)
- First Network statement published in february 2016



Treaty Establishing the Transport Community

What we need

- Continuous strengthening of administrative capacity
- Cooperation and information exchange between rail market regulators, national safety authorities, licensing authorities and authorities in charge for passenger rights

What Railway sector needs

- Cooperation and information sharing between IM and RUs in order to ensure the safety of the rail system
- Cooperation and information sharing between IM, Rus and service facilities in order to ensure the quality of the rail service
- Competitive, customer oriented and efficient rail industry
