Paragraph 5.1.1.3.3., amend to read:

"5.1.1.3.3. The switch shall have a casing with protection degree IP65 in accordance with IEC Standard 60529."

Paragraph 5.1.1.6.3., amend to read (including the insertion of a new footnote 6):

"5.1.1.6.3. Electrical connections

Electrical connections IEC standard 60529 and be designed to prevent accidental disconnection. Connectors shall be in conformity with ISO 12098:2004⁶, ISO 7638:2003⁶ and EN 15207:2006, as appropriate.
