## <u>Insert a new paragraph 2.1.2.13.</u>, to read:

"2.1.2.13. "surveillance camera-monitor-recording device" means a camera and either a monitor or recording equipment other than the camera-monitor device defined in paragraph 2.1.2. which can be fitted to the inside or outside of the vehicle in order to provide fields of vision other than those specified in paragraph 15.2.4. or to provide a security system within or around the vehicle."

## Insert a new paragraph 15.3.6., to read:

"15.3.6. The provisions of this Regulation do not apply to the surveillance cameramonitor-recording devices defined in paragraph 2.1.2.13. Exterior surveillance cameras either shall be mounted at least 2 m above the ground when the vehicle is under a load corresponding to its maximum technical permissible mass, or, if their lower edge is less than 2 m from the ground, shall not project more than 50 mm beyond the overall width of the vehicle measured without this device and have a radii of curvature of not less than 2.5 mm."
