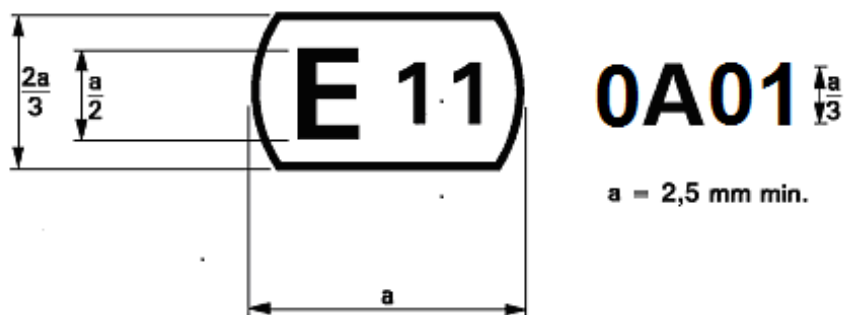

Example of the arrangement of the approval mark

The above approval mark affixed to a LED light source indicates that the light source has been approved in the United Kingdom (E 11) under the approval code 0A01. The first character of the approval code indicates that the approval was granted in accordance with the requirements of Regulation No. 128* in its original form."

* Not requiring changes in the approval number.
