Paragraph 6.1.6., amend to read:

- "6.1.6. When an assembly of two independent lamps to be type approved as "D" lamps having the same function is deemed to be a single lamp, it shall comply with the requirements for:
 - (a) Maximum intensity if all lamps together are lit;
 - (b) Minimum intensity if either lamp has failed."
