Paragraphs 11. to 11.8., replace by the following text:

- "11. TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS
- 11.1. As from the official date of entry into force of the 06 series of amendments, no Contracting Parties applying this Regulation shall refuse to grant ECE approval under this Regulation as amended by the 06 series of amendments.
- 11.2. As from the date of entry into force of the 06 series of amendments, Contracting Parties applying this Regulation shall grant ECE approvals only if the vehicle type to be approved meets the requirements of this Regulation as amended by the 06 series of amendments.
- 11.3. Contracting Parties applying this Regulation shall not refuse to grant extensions of approval in accordance with the preceding series of amendments to this Regulation.
- 11.4. Contracting Parties applying this Regulation shall continue to grant approvals to those types of vehicles which conform to the requirements of this Regulation as amended by the preceding series of amendments until the entry into force of the 06 series of amendments.
- 11.5. ECE approvals granted under this Regulation before the entry into force of the 06 series of amendments and all extensions of such approvals, including those granted subsequently under a preceding series of amendments to this Regulation, shall remain valid indefinitely. When the vehicle type approved under the preceding series of amendments meets the requirements of this Regulation as amended by the 06 series of amendments, the Contracting Party which granted the approval shall so notify the other Contracting Parties applying this Regulation.
- 11.6. No Contracting Party applying this Regulation shall refuse national type approval of a vehicle type approved under the 06 series of amendments to this Regulation or meeting the requirements thereof.
- 11.7. As from 17 June 2003 Contracting Parties applying this Regulation may refuse first national registration (first entry into service) of a vehicle which does not meet the requirements of the 06 series of amendments to this Regulation."
