EUROPEAN AGREEMENT ON IMPORTANT INTERNATIONAL COMBINED
TRANSPORT LINES AND RELATED INSTALLATIONS (AGTC)

GENEVA, 1 FEBRUARY 1991

ACCEPTANCE OF AMENDMENTS TO ANNEXES I AND II TO THE AGTC¹

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, and with reference to depositary notification CN.594.2008.TREATIES-3 of 21 August 2008 concerning the amendments proposed to annexes I and II of the above Agreement, communicates the following:

By 21 February 2009, that is on the expiry of the period of six months following the date of the above depositary notification, no objection had been received. Consequently, the proposed amendments were deemed accepted pursuant to article 15 (4) of the Agreement. In accordance with article 15 (5) of the Agreement, the amendments shall enter into force for all Contracting Parties three months after the date of this notification, i.e., on 23 May 2009.
