### Item 1. Approval of Agenda

Documentation: Draft agenda for Bureau Call on 31 March 2022

1. The agenda was approved.

# Item 2. Email to EGRM Bureau & WG Chairs from Scott Foster (Director, UNECE Sustainable Energy Division) of 28 March

- 2. The Chair noted the email issued by the Director, UNECE Sustainable Energy Division, regarding the current situation in the region following the conflict in Ukraine. It clarified the questions raised by several experts on the upcoming 13<sup>th</sup> Annual Session of the Expert Group on Resource Management. The Director of the UNECE Sustainable Energy Division was invited to speak.
- 3. The Director noted that the ongoing conflict has created a situation that is not conducive to a fruitful exchange of information and collaboration. Therefore, the postponement of the UNECE Resource Management Week 2022, including the 13<sup>th</sup> Annual Session of the Expert Group on Resource Management, should be considered. UNECE will continue to deliver on its mandates, as approved by the General Assembly, promoting regional and transboundary cooperation to achieve sustainable development and support member States to accelerate Agenda 2030 in the region. The representative from the United Kingdom provided clarification on the decisions taken by the UNECE Executive Committee on 24 March 2022.

## Item 3. Organization of EGRM-13

4. The Chair proposed four options for ERGM-13 for consideration: (i) proceed with the organization of EGRM-13 as planned; (ii) organize EGRM-13 in a modified way with only status updates; (iii) postpone the meeting to a later date, and (iv) cancel the meeting altogether.

- 5. The Chair opened the issue for discussion. Following detailed discussions, one Bureau member proposed to postpone EGRM-13. The general consensus was that EGRM-13 should go ahead on 25-29 April but in a modified format. Whilst Russian Federation technical experts would be welcome to participate in EGRM-13, they would not be invited to have prominent speaking roles nor to chair any sessions in line with UNECE Executive Committee Decision ECE/EX/2022/L.6 of 24 March 2022.
- 6. To not exclude those unable to participate, it was recommended that only status updates on EGRM activities be given at EGRM-13. Before the meeting, experts would be encouraged to provide written feedback on UNFC and UNRMS documents. Any documents needing consensus, EGRM, when in session for its 13th meeting (25-29 April), will be invited to consider or otherwise circulate the documents for written feedback for 21 days.
- 7. The Chair agreed to work on a detailed programme based on the above direction and circulate it to the Bureau for approval.

# Item 3. Implementation of EGRM Work Plan 2022-2023

8. The Chair noted that all involved with EGRM have a passionate desire to help the world achieve the Sustainable Development Goals. The work of EGRM could continue in a conducive and cooperative manner to the extent possible.
