

 - Supporting the African Union in the implementation of AMREC (based on UNFC and UNRMS)



 \rightarrow Phase I: 4 years (August 2020 - July 2024) / 2 million EUR Key focus: Implementation of UNFC in European Union, UNECE and beyond

Results and Outcomes:

- UNFC trainings, documents including UNFC Guidance Europe, Network of Practitioners Europe (European expert community)
- Coordination team activities and EU Raw Materials Templates for EU CRMs Act proposal
- EU UNFC activities are most advanced and stand out as a model

Phase II: 4 years (January 2024 – December 2027) / 3 million EUR
