Why we need EIA

- To ensure that environmental and health concerns are considered in the design and implementation of the projects (new projects or their changes or extensions)
- To enable public and public concerned to participate in the environmental decision-making procedures















Main principles

- EIA should be
 - applied to the projects with likely significant environmental impacts
 - carried out early in the preparation of the projects and related decisionmaking process
 - based on correct and complete information
 - focused on relevant environmental impacts and formulate appropriate mitigation measures
 - transparent and participatory taking into account public views















What EIA includes

- 1. Preparation of the EIA report
- 2. Conducting consultations
- 3. Quality control of the EIA report
- Issuing reasoned conclusion on the significant environmental effects
- Integration of reasoned conclusion in the project approval (development consent)















Main actors in EIA

- Project developer (initiator): private or public entity which seeks the project approval
- Environment Agency (competent authority)
- Technical committee
- **Public concerned**: public (one or more natural or legal persons, as well as associations, organizations or groups) that is or can be affected or is interested in environmental decision-making procedures
- Likely affected country (or countries)















International legal framework

- EU EIA Directive (Directive 2011/92/EU as amended by Directive 2014/52/EU)
- UNECE Convention in EIA in a Transboundary Context (Espoo Convention)
- UNECE Convention on Access to Information, Public Participation in Decision-making and Access to Justice in Environmental Matters (Aarhus Convention)
