A. Participation

- 1. Meeting participants must register in the Indico system prior to attending the meeting, please REGISTER HERE.
- 2. Once your registration is approved, you will receive a Digital badge by email.
- 3. **First time entry and badge activation** for meeting participants is via the Pregny Gate from 08.00 to 17.00 hrs on weekdays. The Pregny Gate is located at 14 Avenue de la Paix, in front of the International Committee of the Red Cross building and next to the Geneva Hotel School (see map).
 - Delegates must present their national identification card or passport, as well as their digital badge.
 - Please allow at least 45-60 minutes to pick up your entry badge and reach the Tempus meeting
- 4. **Following activation, the digital badge** permits access via:
 - Pregny Gate, from 08.00 hrs to 17.00 hrs
 - Peace Gate, from 8.00 hrs to 10.00 hrs (subject to security screening), at the Place des Nations, in front of the large Broken Chair and next to the Alley of the Flags (see map).
- 5. The walk from the Pregny Gate to the Tempus meeting room is around 10 minutes and from the Peace Gate around 2 mins.
- 6. **Exit** via Peace Gate and Pregny Gate is possible **until 19.00 hrs**. Exit via Nations Gate (next to Peace Gate) is possible **until 22.00 hrs**. On the days of Receptions, please use the **Nations Gate** to exit.
